RESEARCH

Tommaso Federici has always been fascinated by the innovation process, particularly when a new IT artifact is introduced into an organization, possibly supported by a new organization design. Such innovation might (or may not) generate impacts, either positive or negative, on cultures, persons, habits, structures and performance. This is a frontier territory, possibly to be understood according to multiple perspectives. Hence, Tommaso always tried to follow a multi-disciplinary approach, joining the scholars' and the practitioners' perspectives, and trying to match theoretical rigour with practical relevance.
