- A meeting place for Italians, Americans and for people from all over the world

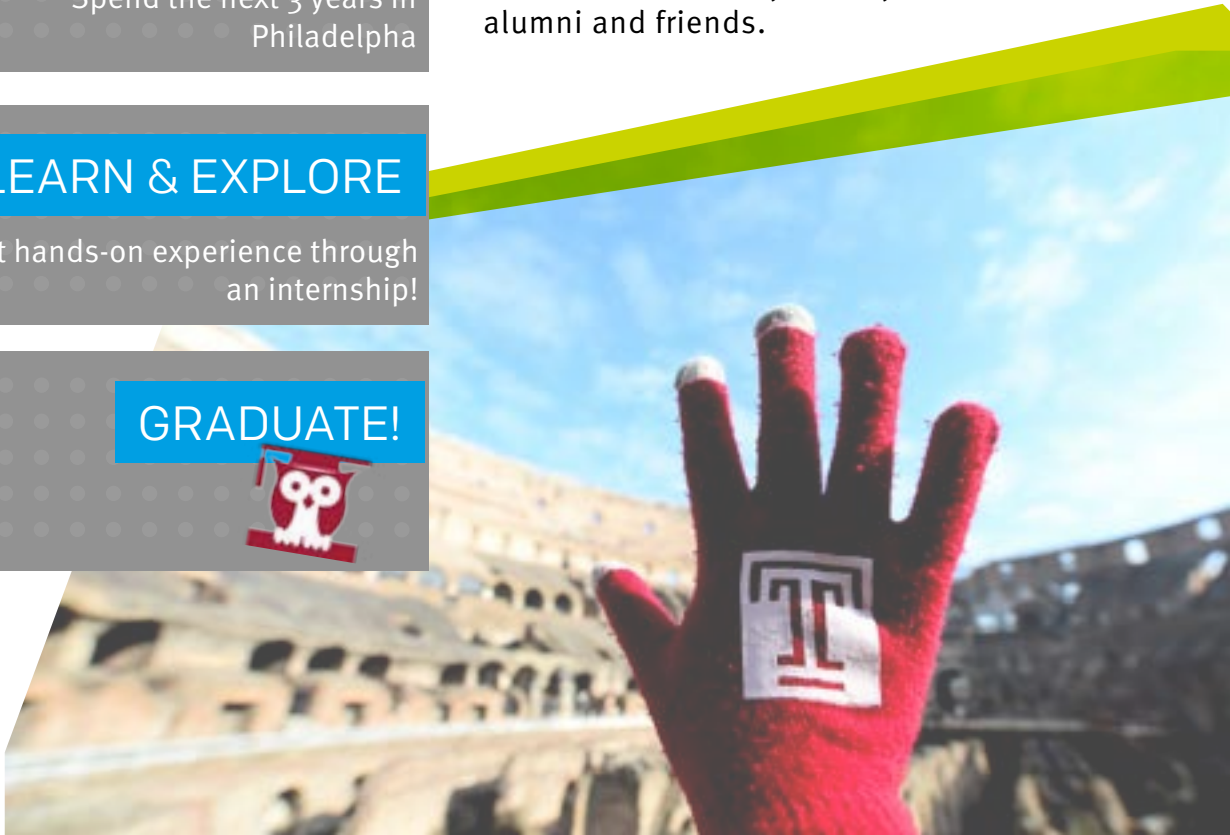

## HOW TO APPLY

**COMPLETE** Temple's undergraduate international application and collect supporting documents;

- Official secondary school transcripts from each school you have attended.
- Standardized Tests: All first-year applicants are required to submit the results of at least one of the following tests: SAT, ACT, TOEFL, IELTS, or PTE.
- Recommendation Letter: At least one recommendation letter is required. Teachers, counselors, and other academic officials can best describe your talents.

**SUBMIT** your application online at [admissions.temple.edu/international](http://admissions.temple.edu/international)

**NOTIFY** the Temple Rome campus of your intention to join the Temple Rome Entry Year program.

**SUBMIT** your tuition deposit to reserve your place.
